

HOW TO: Bold Lemons

CLUB COUTURE™ PROJECT



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Supplies

Club Couture Chalk Transfer® design: Bold Lemons

Chalkology® Paste Singles: Bumblebee, Guava, Meadow*

Coordinating accessory: Acrylic Rectangle (2 Pieces, 5½" x 7¾")

Additional supplies: Color Trays, Mini Squeegee, Fuzzing Cloth, Quick Dry Tool, cotton swab

**Chalkology Paste Singles are subject to change.*

Color and Placement Suggestions

Bumblebee: lemons

Guava: lemon slices, flowers, and select greenery

Meadow: greenery

Instructions

1. Cut along the provided cut line to separate the Transfer's individual elements.
2. Remove the Transfer Backer Sheet from the Transfer element with the lemons and "fuzz" the element on a Fuzzing Cloth. Place the Transfer element on the Acrylic Rectangle and smooth it out to ensure that it has properly adhered and there are no bubbles or wrinkles.
3. Knead the Chalkology Paste Singles. Cut the paste singles open and squeeze the desired amount of Paste onto a Color Tray, using a new tray for each color.
4. Apply paste to the Transfer element (see "Color and Placement Suggestions") using a squeegee. Be sure to chalk the included registration marks on this Transfer element. They are there to help you perfectly line up the next layered Transfer element. When the design has been chalked, remove the Transfer element from the surface.
5. Allow time for the paste to dry. You can use a Quick Dry Tool to expedite the drying process.
6. Once the paste has dried, repeat steps as necessary to chalk the designs from the remaining Transfer element on your surface. Remember to use your registration marks from the last Transfer to properly place the layered element.
7. Use a damp cotton swab to carefully wipe your registration marks off the surface.
8. Allow time for the paste to dry again before stringing the twine through the holes in the Acrylic Rectangle and tying it off with a knot.
9. Immediately clean the Transfer elements with cool water (do not let them soak). Dry the Transfer elements flat with the sticky side up. Once dry, reapply the Transfer Backer Sheets and store flat.
10. Display this citrus-y project and think sweet, summertime thoughts!



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
